And Jehovah had regard for Abel and for his offering. But for Cain and for his offering He had no regard.

Heb. 9:22 And almost all things are purified by blood according to the law, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

You shall make an opening for light for the ark, and you shall finish it up to a cubit from the top; and you shall put the entrance of the ark in its side; you shall make it with lower, second, and third stories.

Phil. 2:12-16 ...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who operates in you both the willing and the working for His good pleasure...that you may become blameless and guileless, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverted generation, among whom you shine as luminaries in the world, holding forth the word of life.
