And I will make of you a great nation, / And I will bless you / And make your name great; / And you shall be a blessing. And I will bless those who bless you, / And him who curses you I will curse; / And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed.

Acts 7:2 ... The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham while he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Haran.

Gen. 12:7-8 And Jehovah appeared to Abram and said, To your seed I will give this land. And there he built an altar to Jehovah who had appeared to him. And he proceeded from there to the mountain on the east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to Jehovah and called upon the name of Jehovah.

Gal. 3:8-9 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles out of faith, announced the gospel beforehand to Abraham: "In you shall all the nations be blessed." So then they who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.

And he blessed him and said, Blessed be Abram of God the Most High, / Possessor of heaven and earth. And blessed be God the Most High, / Who has delivered your enemies into your hand.
