Monday, January 20

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 2:5, 14a To them we yielded with the subjection demanded not even for an hour, that the truth of the gospel might remain with you....But when I saw that they were not walking in a straightforward way in relation to the truth of the gospel.

Tuesday, January 21

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 2:16, 19 And knowing that a man is not justified out of works of law, but through faith in Jesus Christ, we also have believed into Christ Jesus that we might be justified out of faith in Christ and not out of the works of law, because out of the works of law no flesh will be justified....For I through law have died to law that I might live to God.

Wednesday, January 22

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 2:20a I am crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me.
John 6:57 As the living Father has sent Me and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

Thursday, January 23

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 2:20b And the life which I now live in the flesh I live in faith, the faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

2 Cor. 5:14-15 For the love of Christ constrains us because we have judged this, that One died for all, therefore all died; And He died for all that those who live may no longer live to themselves but to Him who died for them and has been raised.

Friday, January 24

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 2:21 I do not nullify the grace of God; for if righteousness is through law, then Christ has died for nothing.

John 1:14, 17 And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality....For the law was given through Moses; grace and reality came through Jesus Christ.

Saturday, January 25

Pray over these key verses:

Gal. 1:3, 15 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ....But when it pleased God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me through His grace.

Rom. 5:17 For if, by the offense of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.
