Monday, July 18

John 3:1-3, “But there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. This one came to Him by night and said to Him, Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher, for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him. Jesus answered and said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God.” notes on 3:2

If I told you of the things on earth and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you of the things in heaven?” note on 3:12
