Monday, July 25

John 4:5-7, "So [Jesus] came to a city of Samaria called Sychar, near the piece of land that Jacob gave to Joseph his son; and Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from the journey, sat thus by the well; it was about the sixth hour. There came a woman of Samaria to draw water. Jesus said to her, Give Me something to drink."

Jesus said to her, You have well said, I do not have a husband, for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband....The woman said to Him....Our fathers worshipped in this mountain, yet you say that in Jerusalem is the place where men must worship." notes on 4:16, 18, 20

God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness." notes 2 and 4 on 4:24
